The Leven Programme's flagship project, the Connectivity Project aims to reconnect the communities within the Levenmouth area to each other and the river, through the creation of a safe and attractive active travel network that is accessible to all.

The network is designed to accommodate the needs of those walking, wheeling, and cycling in the area. The two main components of this project are the active travel network led by Fife Council and off-road river park routes led by Green Action Trust.

Within the river park routes are a range of projects that Green Action Trust is collaborating with wider stakeholders and communities to develop and secure delivery funds for.

In 2020, we published the Levenmouth Active Travel and River Park Concept Design Masterplan, which laid the foundation of our projects and their goals—to deliver an accessible, attractive, and biodiverse public park for the local communities and visitors.

These goals align with the objectives of the Central Scotland Green Network (CSGN), which aims to deliver environmental improvements while maximising social and economic opportunities.

A series of pathway improvements along key routes within Levenmouth that will enable easier and safer travel for those wishing to get around by foot, wheeling or cycling. This also includes a Levenmouth Community Action Plan to encourage more people to adopt walking, wheeling, and cycling in the area. If taken to full delivery, this work has a value of circa £5m.

Project Summary:

The implementation of the Levenmouth Community Action Plan and creation of a new and upgraded 11km active travel network that will be delivered over four phases, featuring:

- Play features and infrastructure
- Signage
- Habitat enhancements
- Drainage improvements
- Social spaces
- Accessibility features
